

Hawse Fairlead Part Number 10102

How to install the Grimm OffRoad Hawse Fairlead part number 10102.

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- 15mm Wrench (1)
- 6mm Allen Key (1)


- Grimm Offroad Hawse Fairlead (1)
- M10x1.5x50mm Button Head Screw (2)
- M10 Washer (2)
- M10x1.5 Flange Nut (2)

Step 1 — Included Parts



Nerify that all parts shown in the picture are present.

Step 2 — Remove Existing Fairlead (If Equiped)



 Remove the existing fairlead if there is one to be replaced.

Step 3 — Route Winch Line Through Fairlead







- Remove any existing hooks from winch line so that the line may be passed through the fairlead.
- Install one washer and button head screw through the fairlead, and then pass the winch line through the fairlead.
- Insert the screw through the fairlead mounting hole and let the fairlead hang.
- Install a flanged nut on the backside of the screw and thread it on a few turns.

Step 4 — Tighten Fairlead Hardware







- Insert hardware through the other side of the fairlead and install nut on backside.
- Snug hardware on each side. With hardware snug, position the fairlead so that the winch line cannot contact the fairlead mount or bumper mount edges.
- (i) With the fairlead correctly positioned, torque hardware to 25 lb-ft [34 Nm].

Step 5 — Torque Hardware



- Install hook on winch line and respool the winch line.
- Recheck hardware and winch line periodically to prevent failure.

Installation is complete!

With any modified vehicle, or any vehicle used offroad, it is a good idea to check bolt torques periodically and visually inspect components regularly.
